effectiveness and serviceability. The vessel is in service since December 2006 and the operational capabilities and vessel economics have proven to be above any expectations.

EXCELLENT FLEXIBILITY

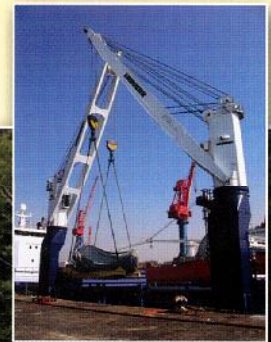
The obstruction free single cargo hold with a length of 61.0 m together with two board cranes with a total tandem capacity of 240 ton and the service speed of 18.0 kn at an engine rating below 3000 kW enables the vessel to provide excellent flexibility for project cargoes all over the world.

The success has resulted in new orders for 5 sister vessels, which will be delivered in 2009-2010.
